



NVMHA Rep Tryout Policy – Junior, U18 and U15AAA Tryouts

This policy provides information for players who are intending to tryout for **Junior, U18 and U15AAA Tryouts**, and who also wish to remain registered for rep tryouts with NVMHA.

Any player registered with NVMHA for rep tryouts must notify the NVMHA Director of Player Safety player@nvmha.com, NVMHA President president@nvmha.com and NVMHA Director of Hockey – operations@nvmha.com by email **prior to** attending camps for **Junior, U18 and U15AAA Tryouts**. If the player progresses to a point in the **Junior, U18 and U15AAA Tryouts** tryout where they will be absent from any portion of the NVMHA Rep tryouts the player will be categorized as “Absent with Permission” for that portion of the rep tryouts.

In order to be categorized as absent with permission the player must:

1. Notify the NVMHA Player Representative player@nvmha.com, NVMHA President president@nvmha.com and NVMHA Director of Hockey – operations@nvmha.com by email prior to attending camps; and
2. Report weekly to NVMHA Director of Player Relations to update their status regarding the **Junior, U18 and U15AAA Tryouts** team tryout. Status reports must be made by email to Director of Player Safety - player@nvmha.com. The Director of Player Safety will coordinate the registry of absent with permission players and document their status reports with the registrar who will log in the players profile.

Should the player return to NVMHA they must notify the Director of Player Safety who will arrange to have the player placed in the A2 working group for evaluation.

Players who fail to notify the NVMHA Director of Player Safety or who fail to report weekly may forfeit their tryout.
