A Message From Canlan





October 4, 2021 Welcome!

Hi Team Manager,

We are really excited to be hosting our first tournament since 2019 with NVMHA! We're so happy to welcome you back.

Please ensure you read the following communication thoroughly and send this messaging to all members of your team. I encourage anyone with questions to reach out. I would be happy to assist in providing clarification on the processes listed below. Please understand that I am not available for debating provincial health orders.

Housekeeping:

- Dressing room access is 30 minutes prior and for 30 minutes after. Please respect this timing so our staff have time to clean the room for the next group. It is courteous.
- Exiting out the side doors on Rinks 1 and 3 are no longer available unless in an emergency situation.

Wild Wina Hours:

Will be open in a concession type format Saturday and Sunday from 4pm – 11pm.
 Unfortunately, due to very low staffing levels, we are unable to expand the service and offerings. We apologize for the inconvenience. We appreciate your patience as we work to provide you with best service we can.

Current Pandemic Protocols:

- Masks are <u>mandatory</u> in <u>all</u> off-ice areas. This includes dressing rooms, lobbies, and viewing areas. This order applies to all patrons born 2009 or earlier (12+ years). Masks are not required if patron is actively engaged in physical activity on the ice.
- Capacity at ice level is 50 people per rink and capacity upstairs is 50%. Therefore, please follow the "rule of 2" 2 spectators per participant. And that includes any siblings etc. There are no capacity requirements in dressing rooms.

Vaccine Passport – what to expect:

- There will only one staff member (possible two) available to check passports due to very low staffing levels. Give yourself time, be prepared, and exercise patience, please.
- Customers enter the tent area from the far end and proceed forward between the designated ropes as they funnel the towards the small tent near the entrance.
- Customers enter the small tent area one person at a time (or two if it's parent and child), where their passports and id will be checked (if necessary and 19+)
- Customers are to provide their government photo id with their BC Vaccine Card (or eligible equivalent until Sept 26)

Canlan Sports It's where we play:







- Once verified, the customer may enter the facility and participate or move around the facility as per the age restriction notes listed below.
- If the customer wants to re-enter the facility, they must go through the same process
- Entry and exit of the building will only be through the front doors. The side arenalevel doors are back to being emergency doors only.
- There will be plenty of signage throughout the facility to assist with wayfinding.

Age restriction notes:

- 11years old and under no requirement, can enter freely
- 12 18 years old no requirement if they are only participating on ice and not visiting any other part of the facility
- 12 18 years old require passport but not photo id if they are spectating, visiting the restaurant, or visiting for any reason other than participating on ice
- 19+ years old require passport and photo id before entering facility for ANY reason

*We may ask a youth for their ID and passport if they appear over 19 years old. A polite response indicating their correct age will all that will be required.

Unvaccinated adults cannot access the facility with youth. These youth should come fully dressed and ready to participate if they require assistance with any equipment. Please ensure you have health and safety volunteers to assist these athletes, if necessary. *All events at Canlan are considered to be 50+ people and therefore require that all 19+ aged individuals at ice level (on or off) must have at least one inoculation.

Please respect, listen to, and help the Canlan Front Line Staff maintain the health and safety of our Canlan community. Please refrain from entering in debates about policies and protocols that they have no control over.

U15 Rules and Regulations

Format "C" Division (Non-Checking) — 12 Teams

General Rules

Tournament will be in accordance with the rules of:

- Canadian Hockey Association (Hockey Canada)
- BC Hockey
- Pacific Coast Amateur Hockey Association (PCAHA)
- North Vancouver Minor Hockey Association (NVMHA)

Protests, Complaints, and Appeals will not be Entertained

Eligibility

- Teams must be in good standing with their respective associations and registered with their respective associations in accordance with Hockey Canada, BC Hockey, and PCAHA.
- Prior to the tournament, each team must submit an official roster (HCR) to the Tournament
 Director. Rules for affiliate players must comply with those outlined in PCAHA regulations.
 Violation of any of these rules will result in disqualification of from the tournament. A player may
 NOT play on more than one team in the tournament, with the exception of affiliate players con
 forming to the rules and procedures outlined by PCAHA regulations.
- Any team that does not have the minimum player requirements ready at the designated start time of any tournament game will be deemed to be in default of the game. In the event of such a default the opposing team (non-defaulting) shall receive a score of 1-0 and two points shall be awarded for the win.

Game Day

- A team official must report to the Tournament Office (upstairs at the top of the stairs at Canlan Ice Sports) at least 30 minutes prior to the scheduled start of each game to confirm their roster for the game.
- The home team shall wear their "home" jersey colour and the visiting teams shall wear an offset ting, alternate jersey colour.

Sportsmanship and Conduct

- Team Officials will be held responsible for conduct of their players and parents, both on and off the ice.
- Please make sure to keep the dressing rooms clean after the games and not to damage the facili
 ties in any way.
- Teams will be responsible for security of their dressing rooms. A padlock is recommended.
- MVP Prizes will be handed out after every game that isn't a medal game. Please choose a different player each game.



Rules

- All tournament games will be 80 minutes in duration with a 5-minute warm up and two
 15-minute periods followed by the 3rd depending on time remaining (determined by referee).
- No overtime in regular tournament play. Finals will be 5 on 5 for 5 minutes. If still tied, 3-man shootout.
- All gameplay rules will follow PCAHA league rules.

Points Win = 2 points

Tie = 1 point Loss = 0 points

Standings/Tiebreaks

Standings after regular tournament play will be totaled and teams will be placed in standings. In the event of tiebreak, standings will be determined in the following order:

- a. Head-to-Head (will not apply if tie consists of more than two teams)
- b. Most wins in seeding games
- c. Fewest goals against (all games combined)
- d. Fewest penalty minutes (all games combined)
- e. Fastest first goal scored of the tournament
- f. Rock Paper Scissors by the starting goalie mom's (best 2 out of 3)

Playoff Format

- 12 Teams in total, makeup two divisions, A and B. The six teams in each of the two divisions play each other once for a total of four games. The top two teams from each division advance to the semi-finals.
- The semi-final games will have the 1st place team from A vs. 2nd place team from B, and the 1st place team from B vs. the 2nd place team from A.
- The winners of the semi-final games will advance to the championship.
- The teams in 3rd, 4th and 5th place in each division will cross over to play their last games as a consolation; 3rd place from A plays the 3rd place from B etc...

Fair Play

All participants are expected to exhibit the guiding principles of minor hockey. Have fun, work hard and follow the codes of conduct and fair play initiatives.
