

## NORTH VANCOUVER MINOR HOCKEY ASSOCIATION REP TRYOUTS - PLAYER WITH MEDICAL EXEMPTION

This notice provides information for players who are unable to participate in NVMHA Rep Tryouts due to a documented medical illness or injury.

A player wishing to tryout for Rep hockey with NVMHA, who has a **documented medical condition, injury or illness**, that prevents them from participating in tryouts must notify the director for Player Safety and the Registrar in order to be categorized as *absent with medical permission* for any portion of the Rep tryouts. The player must present a signed doctor's certificate that states the nature of the illness or injury and estimated rehabilitation time.

Original medical certificates must be presented to the director for Player Safety as follows:

- 1. prior to the first day of tryouts, if the injury/illness occurs prior to tryouts; or
- 2. prior to the next scheduled tryout session if the injury or illness occurs during tryouts.

In addition, a player who is *absent with medical permission* must provide a **weekly status report to the director for Player Safety** (<u>player@nvmha.com</u>). Once a player is medically cleared to return to hockey, the director for Player Safety will arrange to have the player to return to evaluations as follows:

- 1. a player with a recent history of playing Rep hockey will return to is the A2 work group/team for further evaluation; or
- 2. a player with no recent history of playing Rep hockey will be assigned to the A3 work group/ team for evaluation.

Players who fail to provide documentation of medical illness/injury or who fail to report weekly to the director for Player Safety may forfeit their tryout. For more information please contact:
