THE COACHING COMMITMENT

- LEADERSHIP: TO PROVIDE QUALIFIED, EXPERIENCED, AND PREPARED COACHING AT EVERY PRACTICE AND GAME.
- STRUCTURE: TO DELIVER A CLEAR AND ORGANIZED SCHEDULE FOR THE SEASON
- PUNCTUALITY: TO BE AT THE RINK AT THE SAME TIME EXPECTED OF THE PLAYERS (1 HOUR BEFORE GAMES).
- Accountability: To follow the framework and direction of the NVMHA Board and Director of Hockey Operations.



PLAYERS COMMITMENT

AVAILABILITY: BE PRESENT AND ON TIME FOR ALL PRACTICES, GAMES, AND TEAM EVENTS.

EFFORT: GIVE 100% EFFORT AND FOCUS IN ALL SITUATIONS.

RESPECT: Uphold the Fair Play Code by showing respect for teammates, opponents, and officials.

PROFESSIONALISM: MAINTAIN PEAK PHYSICAL CONDITION AND ADHERE TO THE TEAM DRESS CODE.



PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT

- 1. I WILL PLAY HOCKEY BECAUSE I WANT TO, NOT BECAUSE OTHERS OR COACHES WANT ME TO.
- 2. WILL PLAY BY THE RULES OF HOCKEY AND IN THE SPIRIT OF THE GAME.
- 3. I WILL CONTROL MY TEMPER FIGHTING OR "MOUTHING-OFF" CAN SPOIL THE ACTIVITY OF EVERYONE.
- 4. WILL RESPECT MY OPPONENTS.
- 5. I WILL DO MY BEST TO BE A TRUE TEAM PLAYER.
- 6.I WILL REMEMBER THAT WINNING ISN'T EVERYTHING THAT HAVING FUN, IMPROVING SKILLS, MAKING FRIENDS AND DOING MY BEST ARE ALSO IMPORTANT.
- 7. I WILL ACKNOWLEDGE ALL GOOD PLAYS AND PERFORMANCES THOSE OF MY TEAM AND MY OPPONENTS.
- 8.I WILL REMEMBER THAT COACHES AND OFFICIALS ARE THERE TO HELP ME. I WILL ACCEPT THEIR DECISIONS AND SHOW THEM RESPECT.



PARENTS COMMITMENT

- Support: Encourage your player's commitment and focus on effort over the outcome of the game.
- Communication: Notify the Coach or Manager of any absence in advance through proper channels (text, email, or phone).
- **RESPECT: M**ODEL POSITIVE BEHAVIOR BY RESPECTING ALL PLAYERS, COACHES, OFFICIALS, AND OTHER PARENTS.
- PARTNERSHIP: TRUST THE PROCESS AND SUPPORT THE TEAM AND COACHES.

PARENT CODE OF CONDUCT

FAIR PLAY CODE

- I WILL NOT FORCE MY CHILD TO PARTICIPATE IN HOCKEY.

 I WILL REMEMBER THAT MY CHILD PLAYS HOCKEY FOR THEIR ENJOYMENT, NOT MINE.
- I WILL ENCOURAGE MY CHILD TO PLAY BY THE RULES AND TO RESOLVE CONFLICT WITHOUT RESORTING TO HOSTILITY OR VIOLENCE.
- I WILL TEACH MY CHILD THAT DOING ONE'S BEST IS AS IMPORTANT AS WINNING SO THAT MY CHILD WILL NEVER FEEL DEFEATED BY THE OUTCOME OF THE GAME.
- I WILL MAKE MY CHILD FEEL LIKE A WINNER EVERY TIME BY OFFERING PRAISE FOR COMPETING FAIRLY AND HARD.
- WILL NEVER RIDICULE OR YELL AT MY CHILD FOR MAKING A MISTAKE OR LOSING A GAME.
- WILL REMEMBER THAT CHILDREN LEARN BY EXAMPLE.
- I WILL APPLAUD GOOD PLAYS AND PERFORMANCES BY BOTH MY CHILD'S TEAM AND THEIR OPPONENTS.
- I WILL NEVER QUESTION THE OFFICIAL'S JUDGMENT OR HONESTY IN PUBLIC.
 I RECOGNIZE OFFICIALS ARE BEING DEVELOPED IN THE SAME MANNER AS PLAYERS.
- I WILL SUPPORT ALL EFFORTS TO REMOVE VERBAL AND PHYSICAL ABUSE FROM CHILDREN'S HOCKEY GAMES.
- I WILL RESPECT AND SHOW APPRECIATION FOR THE VOLUNTEERS WHO GIVE THEIR TIME TO HOCKEY FOR MY CHILD.



LOGISTICS & FEES

- Game Day Dress Code (U13-U18):
 - FORMAL ATTIRE: DRESS SHIRT, TIE, DRESS PANTS, DRESS SHOES, TEAM JACKET.
- Blue Helmets are required for all players.
- Team Roster Size:
- STANDARD ROSTERS ARE 15 SKATERS AND 1-2 GOALIES.
- Rep Team Fees:
- ESTIMATED BUDGET: \$2,000 \$3,500 PER PLAYER.
- FEES COVER COACHING HONORARIUM ADDITIONAL ICE, REFEREE FEES, TOURNAMENT ENTRY, OFF-ICE TRAINING, AND TEAM EXPENSES.

U11 ONLY DECLARED POSITIONS

PER THE NVMHA REP TRYOUT - DECLARED POSITIONS POLICY - PLAYERS ARE NOT SELECTED FOR U11 REP TEAMS BASED OFF THEIR DECLARED TRYOUT POSITION.

- THE TOP OVERALL RANKED SKATERS WILL BE SELECTED FOR A1, A2, A3, A4.
- Goalies are the only position selected based off their declaration.

EVALUATION PROCESS

- EVALUATORS HAVE A ROTATION TO ENSURE THEY EVALUATE ALL PLAYERS.
- EACH PLAYER WILL HAVE A MINIMUM OF 4 ICE TIMES.
- 1 SKILLS ASSESSMENT (COMBINE). 3 GAMES.
- NVMHA USES TEAM GENIUS TO PROCESS ALL SCORES AND USES THESE RESULTS FOR RANKING





WHAT ARE WE LOOKING FOR?

- Hockey Sense: Reading the play, anticipation, and decision-making.
- **Skating & Skills:** Puck control, passing, shooting, and overall technical ability.
- Compete & Attitude: Work ethic, drive, coachability, and sportsmanship.
- **Team Play:** Positional awareness and ability to contribute to team success both on and off the ice.
- Coachability Based on last season evaluations (when available)

COMMUNICATION & TEAM FORMATION

- Assignments: All communication for Phase 2 Working Groups will be sent via email.
- FEEDBACK: REQUESTS FOR AN EXPLANATION OF A PLAYER'S EVALUATION MUST BE MADE IN WRITING VIA THE OFFICIAL ONLINE FORM. THESE WILL BE REVIEWED AFTER TRYOUTS CONCLUDE IN LATE SEPTEMBER.
- Final Rosters: Teams will be finalized within 10-15 days after the commencement of Phase 2 as per NVMHA Policy. (Subject to change based on RECOMMENDATION FROM DOH)



Roster Deadlines

THE COACHES OF THE A1, A2, A3, A4 TEAMS WILL COMPLETE ALL RELEASES IN ORDER TO HAVE THEIR TEAMS AT THE APPROVED ROSTER SIZE BY:

- A1 TEAM BY SEPTEMBER 12
- A2 TEAM BY SEPTEMBER 17
- A3 TEAM BY SEPTEMBER 21
- A4 TEAM BY OCT 1

Any variation in any of the deadlines above must be approved in advance by the Director of Hockey Operations.

U15 REGIONAL Program

- New U15 A1 Program for our A1 Team
- WE ARE STRIVING TO CREATE AN ENVIRONMENT THAT WILL PRODUCE WELL-ROUNDED YOUNG HOCKEY PLAYERS, BOTH ON AND OFF THE ICE.
- EDUCATION, LEADERSHIP, RESPECT AND STRONG WORK ETHIC DESCRIBE OUR NEW PROGRAM. OUR PLAYERS WILL BE EQUIPPED WITH THE SKILLS REQUIRED, TO TAKE THEIR GAME TO THE NEXT LEVEL.
- THE GOAL OF INTRODUCING THIS NEW PROGRAM IS TO PROVIDE OUR PLAYERS WITH A COMPLETE AND LONG-TERM DEVELOPMENT MODEL, ALONG WITH A STEPPING-STONE TO ACADEMY AND ZONE HOCKEY OPTIONS THAT DOESN'T INVOLVE LEAVING MINOR HOCKEY OR DISRUPTING THEM ACADEMICALLY.
